**A further additional two hours into the morning following every Saturday and Sunday of every Easter Bank Holiday, May Bank Holiday, Spring/Whitsun Bank Holiday and every August Bank Holiday weekend.**

**An extension from the end of permitted hours on New Years Eve to the start of permitted hours New Years Day every year.**

**Upon 28 days notice being provided to South Wales Police, an additional two hours, (until 6am Saturday into Sunday morning), to be requested with South Wales Police written confirmation being required prior to its operation. This is not applicable in respect of Bank Holiday's and New Year's Eve as above.**
