2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer at Room 206, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff CF10 4UW on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday 27 March to Friday 31 March and Monday 3 April between 9 am and 4.30 pm inclusive, Wednesday 29 March between 6 – 8 pm and Tuesday 4 April between 9 am and 4 pm but no later than **4pm**.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th May 2017.
4. Applications to be added to the register of electors in order to vote at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 206, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, CF10 4UW by Thursday, 13 April 2017. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 206, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, CF10 4UW by 5 pm on Tuesday, 18th April 2017.
6. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 206, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, CF10 4UW by 5 pm on Tuesday, 25th April 2017.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 206, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, CF10 4UW by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th May 2017. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Tuesday, 25th April 2017. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Tuesday, 25th April 2017
