THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF CARDIFF (PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2023 (AMENDMENT NO.13) ORDER 2024

The County Council of the City and County of Cardiff in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended, The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (General Provisions) (Wales) Regulations 2013, The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (City and County of Cardiff) Designation Order 2010, and of all other enabling powers proposes making an Order the general effect of which will be to amend the above named order and in particular map tile references AH23 and AH24 (annexed to the draft Order) which will be to prevent you from waiting at any time in:

- I. Albert Street, on both sides from its junction with Wellington Street for a distance of 7 metres south east
- II. Wellington Street, on its south east side from a point 7 metres north east of its junction with Albert Street to a point 7 metres south west of the same junction

Exemptions will be permitted for boarding and alighting from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for essential services and funerals and for a maximum period of three hours vehicles when displaying a "Disabled Badge" and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons.

Any objections and other representations relating to the order must be submitted in writing on or before 7th February 2024 or by email to <u>roadtrafficorderobjections@cardiff.gov.uk.</u> In the case of an objection this must contain a statement of the grounds on which the objection is made. Correspondence may be disclosed as required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Council welcomes correspondence in English and Welsh and we will ensure that we communicate with you in the language of your choice, whether that's English, Welsh or bilingual as long as you let us know which you prefer. The County Council of the City and County of Cardiff in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the 1984 Act"), Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (City and County of Cardiff) Designation Order 2010, The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (General Provisions) (Wales) Regulations 2013 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer, South Wales Police, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, proposes making an Order the general effect of which will be to establish a Disabled Persons' Parking Place (for use by any Disabled Persons' Badge Holder) in the length of road referred to in the Schedule below (as shown on Map Tile References AH23 and AH24 annexed to the draft Order).

Exemptions will be permitted for the following reasons:

- a. Boarding or alighting from a vehicle
- b. Emergency services
- c. Essential services




