THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF CARDIFF (PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS OF STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2023 (AMENDMENT NO.9) ORDER 2024

The County Council of the City and County of Cardiff in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (“the 1984 Act”), Part IV of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer, South Wales Police, in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, proposes making an Order the general effect of which will be to:

- I. establish a Disabled Persons’ Parking Place in Comet Street on its north west side from a point 69 metres south west of its junction with System Street for a distance of 6.6 metres south west (as shown on Map Tile Reference AG29 annexed to the draft Order)
- II. remove the Disabled Persons’ Parking Place in Galston Road in the vicinity of 18 Galston Street and reinstate residents parking (as shown on Map Tile Reference AG29 annexed to the draft Order)

A copy of the draft order and plan showing the location and extent of the restrictions are available, you can obtain a copy by sending an email request to roadtrafficorderobjections@cardiff.gov.uk or by making a written request to the address below. Full details of the order are also available at www.cardiff.gov.uk/trafficorders.

Any objections and other representations relating to the order must be submitted in writing on or before 26th January 2024 or by email to roadtrafficorderobjections@cardiff.gov.uk and must contain the grounds on which you object. Correspondence may be disclosed as required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

This Notice may be removed after the objection period ends. The Council welcomes correspondence in English and Welsh and we will ensure that we communicate with you in the language of your choice, whether that’s English, Welsh or bilingual as long as you let us know which you prefer. Corresponding in Welsh will not lead to any delay. This document is available in Welsh/Mae’r ddogfen hon ar gael yn Gymraeg.

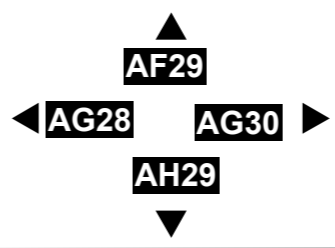
