

The County Council of the City and County of Cardiff (Lawrenny Avenue, Cardiff) (School Street) (Prohibition of Traffic) (Experimental) Order 2023

On the 23rd of August 2023 the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, made an Order the general effect of which is to prohibit Motor Vehicles from entering and proceeding along Lawrenny Avenue. This prohibition shall only apply during "Term Time" between the hours of 08:15-09:15 and 14:30-15:45 Monday to Friday (inclusive). "Term Time" for the purposes of this notice and corresponding Order shall mean the Academic Year (between 1st September and 31st July) Term Time" for the purposes of this notice and corresponding Order shall mean the Academic Year (between 1st September and 31st July) Term Time" for July) and for the avoidance of any doubt shall exclude school holidays, further information is available at <u>School term</u> <u>dates (cardiff.gov.uk)</u>.

Exemptions shall be permitted for vehicles displaying a valid permit with permit reference SZ9 (please note that any business, religious or community premises only accessible from Lawrenny Avenue are eligible to apply for such permits).

The Experimental Order will come into operation on 4th of September 2023 and will remain in force of a period of 18 months pursuant to and subject to the provisions contained in Section 9 of the 1984 Act.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of this Order should continue to remain in force indefinitely. Any objections and other correspondence relating to the order continuing indefinitely must be submitted in writing and addressed to Director of Governance & Legal Services midnight on the 4th of March 2024 (or by email to <u>roadtrafficorderobjections@cardiff.gov.uk</u>). Correspondence may be disclosed as required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Copies of the order and plans showing the location and extent of the restriction are available, you can only obtain copies by sending an email request to <u>roadtrafficorderobjections@cardiff.gov.uk</u>, by making a written request to the address below or by scanning the QR code below.

This Notice may be removed after the objection period ends. The Council welcomes correspondence in English and Welsh and we will ensure that we communicate with you in the language of your choice, whether that's English, Welsh or bilingual as long as you let us know which you prefer. Corresponding in Welsh will not lead to any delay. This document is available in Welsh/Mae'r ddogfen hon ar gael yn Gymraeg.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within six weeks from the date on which the order was made apply to the High Court for this purpose.
