

Dorchester Avenue And Winchester Avenue - Road Closures

Description of Scheme Proposal

A request was received from the Local Ward Members for Penylan to investigate their road safety concerns at Dorchester Avenue. A Transport Investigation was undertaken which included a full assessment of the location comprising of speed surveys, traffic flow and collision data.

The surveys undertaken identified that vehicles are using Dorchester Avenue and Winchester Avenue as an alternative route in order to avoid the traffic controlled signal junction at Colchester Avenue and Pen-y-Lan Road. This is in contravention of the existing "Access Only" restriction for this local access road.

It was agreed that the most suitable option would be to introduce bollards at Dorchester Avenue and Winchester Avenue at their junctions with Pen-y-Lan Road. There would be a requirement to introduce double yellows indicating "No Waiting At Any Time" in order to create a turning head for vehicles to safely and conveniently manoeuvre.

Cyclist access will be permitted through the road closures.

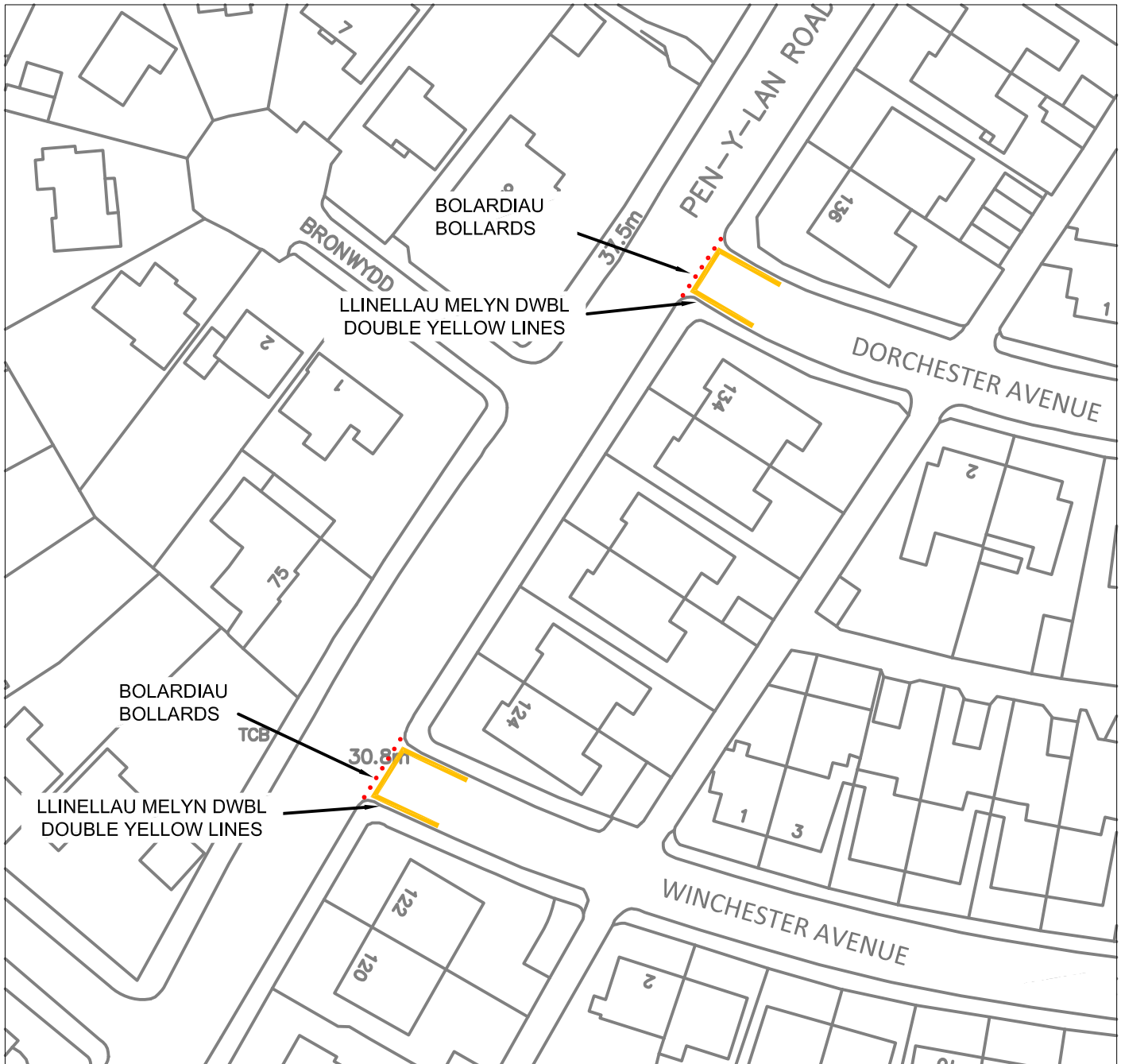
Additional Information about traffic management measures

Traffic Regulation Order. These are the restrictions placed on the Highway that direct, control and prohibit road user movements. For example 20mph speed limits. No Entry. No Right Turn. One Way. No Waiting. These regulations must pass through a lengthy legal process. If approved, the signs or lines are placed on site and enforced by the Police or their Traffic Wardens.

Bollard. This is a post made of various materials and is used to deter vehicles being driven onto the footway or verge.
