

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in accordance with Section 28(1) (b) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998, and the Education (School Organisation Proposals) (Wales) Regulations 1999 (S.I. 1999/1671), that the Council of the City and County of Cardiff (herein after "the Authority"), having consulted such persons as appeared to them to be appropriate, proposes to:

Make a prescribed alteration to Radyr Primary School, Park Road, Radyr, Cardiff, CF15 8DF (hereinafter "the School") by extending the age range of the School from 4-11 to 3-11.

It is proposed to provide 32 part time equivalent (PTE) nursery places. This will enable up to 32 children aged 3-4 (from the term following their third birthday) to receive part time nursery education at the School.

Parents of children who are admitted for nursery education will still need to apply for a place at the School if they wish their child to transfer to the reception class. Attendance at the nursery will not guarantee admission to the School.

It is intended that the proposal will be implemented from September 2013.

The number of pupils to be admitted to the School in Reception at age 4 or 5 in the first school year in which the proposal to open the nursery is implemented will be 45.

The Authority has responsibility for admitting pupils to the School and set the admission criteria.

The School will remain a Community school and will continue to admit pupils of both sexes.

Within a period of 1 month after the date of publication of this proposal, that is to say by 01 August any person may object to the proposal. Objections should be sent to the Chief Officer, Education Service, Cardiff County Council, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff CF10 4UW.

Please note that any objection sent by post or e-mail must contain the full name and postal address of the objector.

The Authority will send copies of any such objections made (and not withdrawn in writing) within the objection period, together with its observations thereon, to the Welsh Government within a period of 2 weeks after the end of the objection period.

The proposal will (unless withdrawn) require the approval of the Welsh Ministers if,

- a) within 2 months after a copy of the proposal is sent to the Welsh Ministers they give notice that they require such approval; or
- b) any objection has been made within the objection period and has not been withdrawn in writing during that period.

Where a proposal does not require such approval, the Authority will decide whether to implement the proposal. Such determination shall be made within 4 months after a copy of the said proposal was sent to the Welsh Ministers and the determination shall then be notified to the Welsh Ministers.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This does not form part of the Notice but is intended to explain its general meaning.

It is proposed, that the age range of Radyr Primary School is extended from 4-11 to 3-11 by incorporating a nursery for 32 part time equivalent (PTE) nursery places.

It is proposed that a 32 part time place nursery is established at Radyr Primary School. This will enable up to 32 children aged 3-4 (from the term following their third birthday) until they enter a Reception class) to receive part time nursery education at Radyr Primary School. Attendance at the nursery will not guarantee a child a reception class place in the primary school.

The admissions criteria for the nursery and primary school will be made available as part of Cardiff Council's "Admissions to Schools" booklet.

To provide a nursery at Radyr Primary School some internal alterations will be made in the main school building along with the provision of a demountable building to provide additional accommodation. The nursery will be located in the main school building with an increased number of primary aged pupils being accommodated in the demountable classrooms. The location and installation of the demountable unit is subject to planning consent.

HYSBYSIR DRWY HYN yn unol ag adran 28(1)(b) Deddf Safonau a Fframwaith Ysgolion 1998 a Rheoliadau Addysg (Cynigion Trefniadaeth Ysgolion) (Cymru) 1999 (S.I. 1999/1671), fod Cyngor Dinas a Sir Caerdydd (sef 'yr Awdurdod' o hyn ymlaen), ar ôl ymgynghori â'r unigolion priodol, yn cynnig:

Gwneud addasiad rhagnoddedig i Ysgol Gynradd Radur, Park Road, Radur, Caerdydd, CF15 8DF (sef 'yr Ysgol' o hyn ymlaen) drwy ymestyn ystod oedran yr Ysgol o 4-11 i 3-11.

Cynigir darparu 32 o leoedd meithrin cyfwerth â rhan amser. Bydd hyn yn galluogi hyd at 32 o blant 3-4 oed (o'r tymor yn dilyn eu pen-blwydd yn dair oed) i gael addysg feithrin ran amser yn yr Ysgol.

Bydd rhaid, o hyd, i rieni'r plant sy'n derbyn lle addysg feithrin gwneud cais am le yn yr Ysgol os ydynt am i'w plentyn drosglwyddo i'r dosbarth derbyn. Nid yw mynychu'r feithrinfa yn sicrhau mynediad i'r Ysgol.

Bwriedir gweithredu'r cynigion hyn o fis Medi 2013.

Ym mlyddyn gyntaf yr ysgol pan gaiff y cynnig i agor y feithrinfa ei weithredu, caiff 45 o ddisgyblion eu derbyn i'r Ysgol yn y Dosbarth Derbyn yn 4 neu 5 oed.

Yr Awdurdod sy'n gyfrifol am dderbyn disgyblion i'r Ysgol a phennu'r meini prawf derbyn.

Bydd yr Ysgol yn parhau'n Ysgol Gymunedol a bydd yn parhau i dderbyn bechgyn a merched.

O fewn cyfnod o 1 mis ar ôl dyddiad cyhoeddi'r cynnig hwn, hynny yn erbyn 01 Awst, gall unrhyw berson wrthwynebu'r cynnig. Dylid anfon gwrthwynebiadau at y Prif Swyddog, Gwasanaeth Addysg, Cyngor Sir Caerdydd, Neuadd y Sir, Glanfa'r Iwerydd, Caerdydd, CF10 4UW.

Rhaid cael caniatâd cynllunio i leoli a gosod yr uned dros dro.
