

TRAFFIC PROPOSALS

The County Council of The City and County of Cardiff (Prohibitions and Restrictions of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2024 (Amendment No 57) Order 2026

The County Council of the City and County of Cardiff in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended, The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (General Provisions) (Wales) Regulations 2013, The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (City and County of Cardiff) Designation Order 2010, and of all other enabling powers proposes making an Order the general effect of which will be to prevent you from waiting at any time in the lengths of road listed in the Schedule below.

Exemptions for the lengths of road set out in the Schedule below will be permitted for the following reasons:-

- a) boarding and alighting a vehicle
- b) loading and unloading of goods
- c) essential services and funerals
- d) for a maximum period of three hours vehicles when displaying a "Disabled Badge" and a "Parking Disc" and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons

This notice forms part of a larger proposal. Any objections and other representations relating to the order must be submitted in writing on or before 31 July 2026 or by email to roadtrafficorderobjections@cardiff.gov.uk. In the case of an objection this must contain a statement of the grounds on which the objection is made. Correspondence may be disclosed as required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

This Notice may be removed after the objection period ends. The Council welcomes correspondence in English and Welsh and we will ensure that we communicate with you in the language of your choice, whether that's English, Welsh or bilingual as long as you let us know which you prefer. Corresponding in Welsh will not lead to any delay. This document is available in Welsh/Mae'r ddogfen hon ar gael yn Gymraeg.

Schedule

- 1) Mervyn Road on its south west side from a point 19 metres north west of its junction with Norman Road to a point 5 metres south west of the same junction, & on its south east side from its junction with Llancaiach Road for a distance of 5 metres south west, & on its east side from its junction with Plas Treoda for a distance of 15 metres north, & on its west side from a point 7 metres north east of its junction with Merthyr Road for a distance of 15 metres north
- 2) Llancaiach Road on its south side from its junction with Norman Road for a distance of 6 metres south east and on its both sides from its junction with Heol Stradling for a distance of 7 metres south west
- 3) Norman Road on its north side from its junction with Mervyn Road for a distance of 8 metres west and on its south side from the same junction for a distance of 6 metres west
- 4) Heol Stradling on its south east side from a point 7 metres north west of its junction with Llancaiach Road to a point 7 metres south east of the same junction and on its both sides from its junction with Plas Treoda for a distance of 7 metres north
- 5) Plas Treoda on its south side from its junction with Merthyr Road for a distance of 155 metres west and from its junction with Caegwyn Road for a distance of 11 metres south west & on its north side from its junction with Mervyn Road for a distance of 17 metres east; and from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Heol Stradling to a point 5 metres east of the same junction; and from its junction

with Manor Rise for a distance of 12 metres south west; and from its junction with Caegwyn Road for a distance of 9 metres west

- 6) Manor Rise on its west side from its junction with Plas Treoda for a distance of 9 metres north and on its east side from its junction with Caegwyn Road for a distance of 9 metres north

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- 1) Prevent you from waiting at any time in the lengths of road listed in the Schedule below.

Exemptions for the lengths of road set out in the Schedule below will be permitted for the following reasons:-

- a) boarding and alighting a vehicle
- b) loading and unloading of goods
- c) essential services and funerals
- d) for a maximum period of three hours vehicles when displaying a "Disabled Badge" and a "Parking Disc" and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons

- 2) Establish a Disabled Persons Parking Place in Caegwyn Road on its west side from a point 78 metres south east of its junction with Plas Treoda for a distance of 14 metres south

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Schedule

- 1) Caegwyn Road on its south side from its junction with Plas Treoda for a distance of 15 metres east and from a point 25 metres east from its junction with Plas Treoda for a distance of 33 metres east & on its south east side from a point 7 metres north of its junction with Greenclose Road to a point 7 metres south of the same junction; and from a point 45 metres south of its junction with Greenclose Road for a distance of 29 metres south; and from a point 79 metres south of its junction with Greenclose Road for a distance of 7 metres south; and from a point 100 metres south of its junction with Greenclose Road for a distance of 7 metres south; and from a point 116 metres south of its junction with Greenclose Road for a distance of 11 metres south (including its closed end) & on its south west side from the junction of Caegwyn Road (closed end) for a distance of 6 metres north
- 2) Greenclose Road on its both sides from its junction with Caegwyn Road for a distance of 11 metres south east

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- 1) Prevent you from waiting between the hours of 8am – 6:30pm Monday to Saturday (inclusive) in Plas-Y-Llan on its north west side from a point 10 metres north east of its junction with Penlline Road for a distance of 115 metres north east (including the turning head)
- 2) prevent you from waiting at any time in the lengths of road listed in the Schedule below.

Exemptions for the lengths of road set out in this notice will be permitted for the following reasons:-

- a) boarding and alighting a vehicle
- b) loading and unloading of goods
- c) essential services and funerals
- d) for a maximum period of three hours vehicles when displaying a “Disabled Badge” and a “Parking Disc” and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons

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Schedule

- 1) Davis's Terrace on its south side from its junction with Old Church Road for a distance of 7 metres south west
- 2) Old Church Road on its east side from its junction with Davis's Terrace for a distance of 11 metres north
- 3) Bethel Lane on its
 - i) north west side from a point 7 metres north east of its junction with Coach House Lane for a distance of 31 metres north east and from a point 7 metres north east of its junction with Penlline Road for a distance of 33 metres north east
 - ii) South east side from a point 7 metres north east of its junction with Coach House Lane for a distance of 32 metres north east
- 4) Coach House Lane on its both sides from a point 7 metres north west of its junction with Bethel Lane for a distance of 26 metres north west and from a point 7 metres south east of its junction with Old Church Road for a distance of 27 metres south east

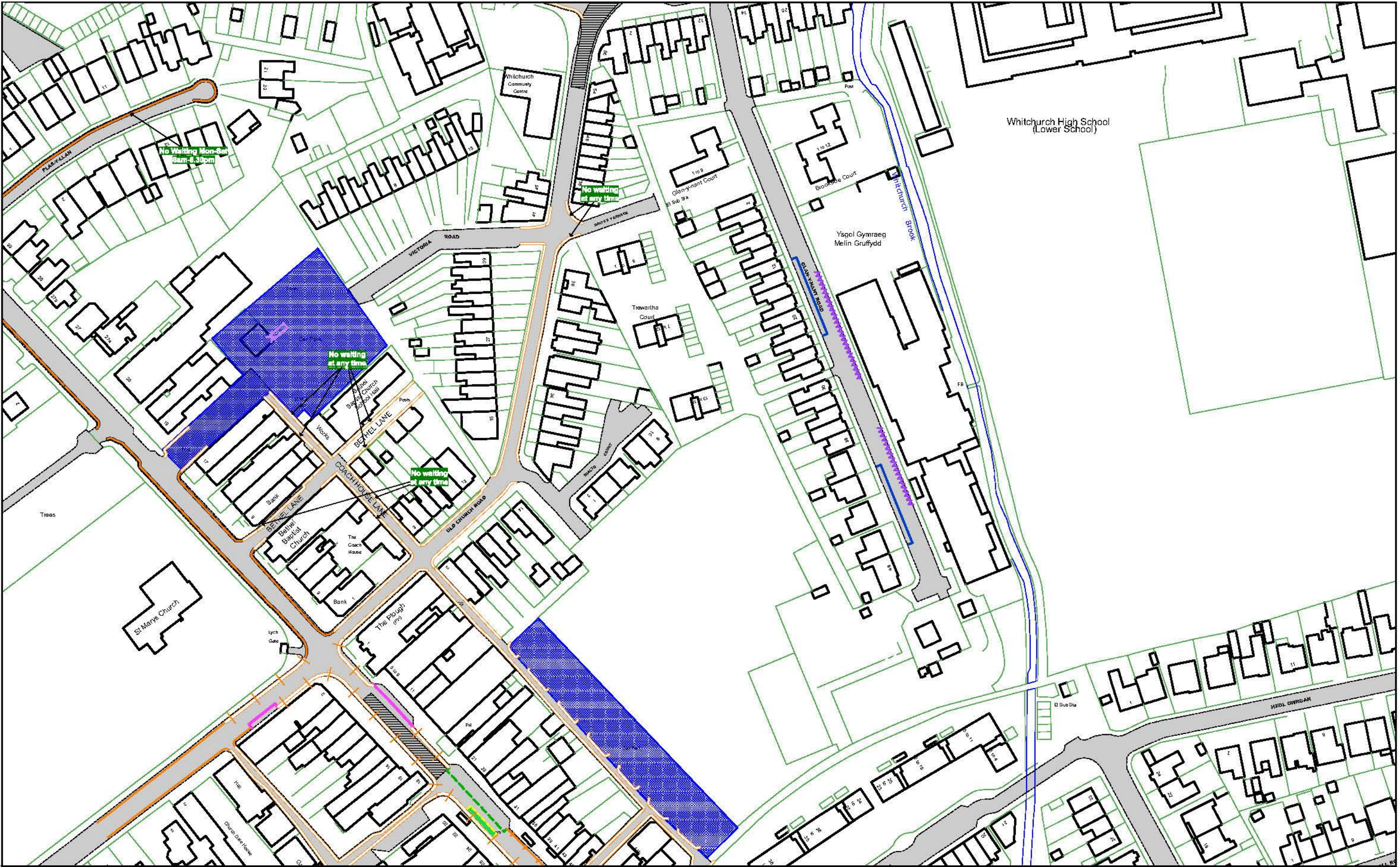

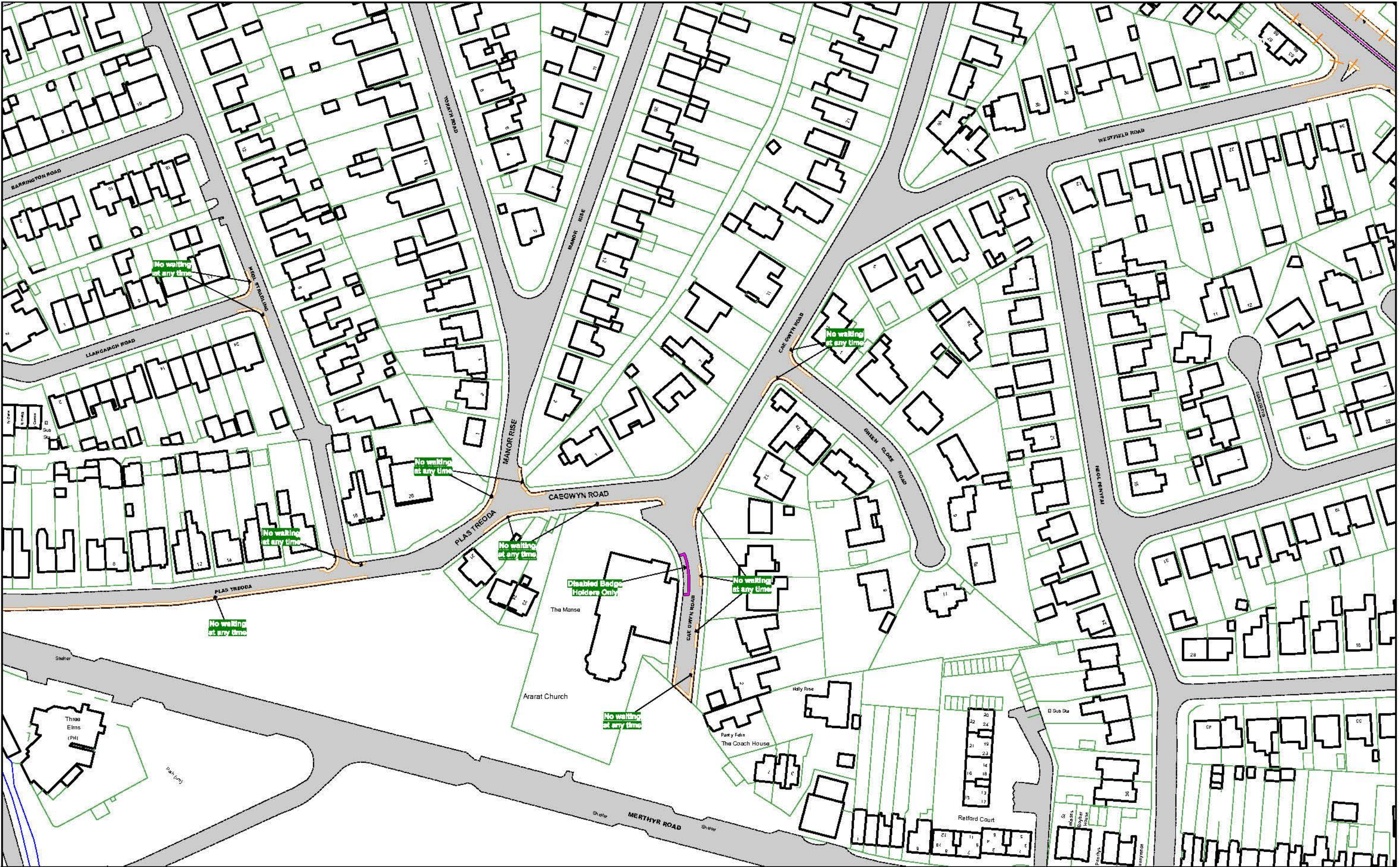
