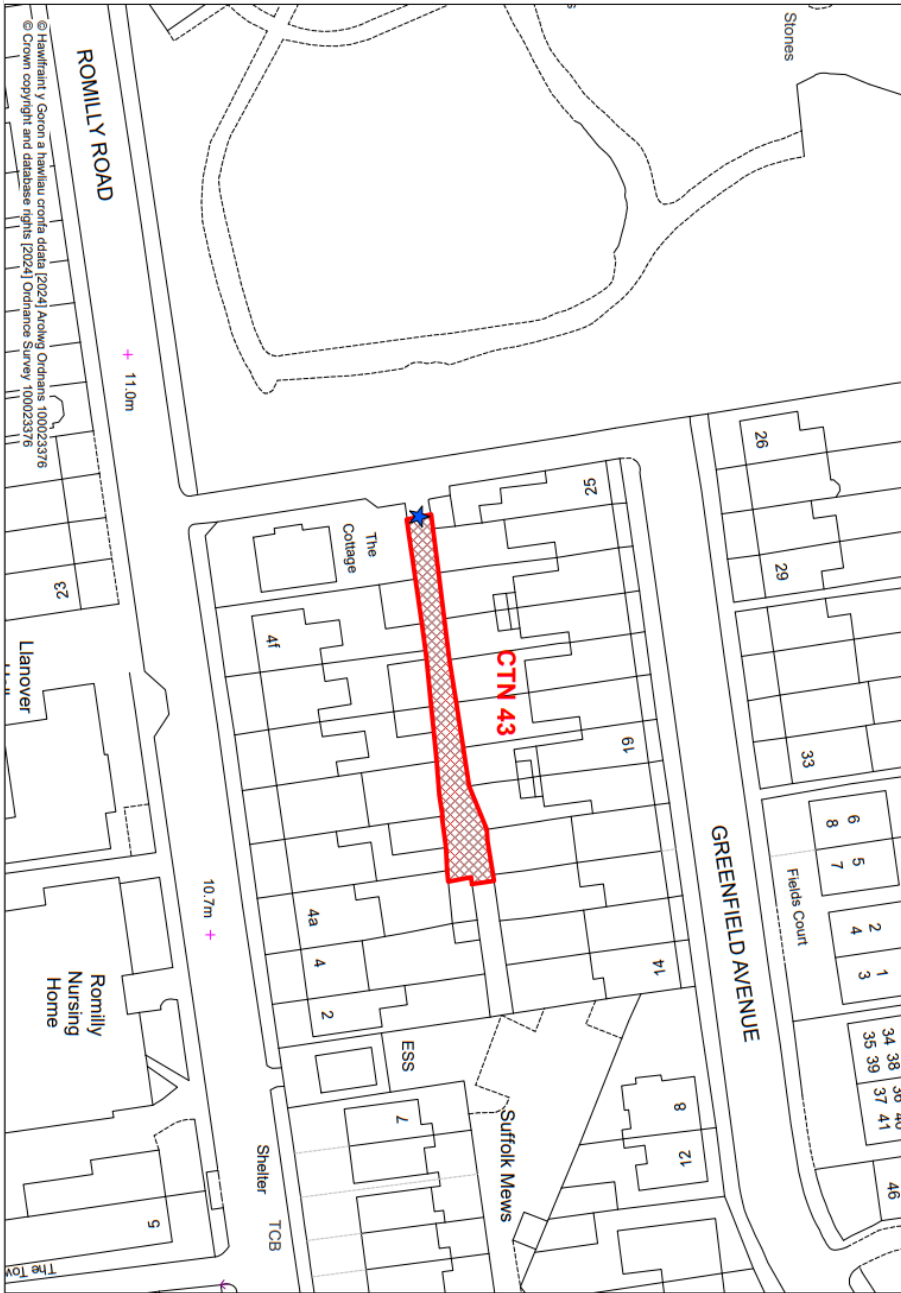

Public Spaces Protection Order Notice

Notice Is Hereby Given that the County Council of the City and County of Cardiff propose to make a Public Spaces Protection Order under Sections 59, 64 and 72 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policy Act 2014 that will affect a Public Place namely:

The public path:

To the rear of 17-25 Greenfield Avenue, Canton (“the Restricted Area”),

as shown as cross hatched on the attached plan. The purpose of the Order will be to restrict all public access through this area. It is proposed that barriers will be erected at the end of the Restricted Area.

The proposal has been made because the Council is satisfied that crime and anti-social behaviour have been or are likely to be carried out in the Restricted Area and have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality and are likely to be of a persistent or continuing nature.

The Council believes that the application of the restriction of public access to the aforementioned Restricted Area imposed by the Order will assist in reducing the activities above from continuing, occurring or recurring/or to reduce the risk of its continuance, occurrence or recurrence and justifies the restrictions proposed by this Notice.

If the proposed order is made, the alternative route available to pedestrians, if any, will be as shown by the dotted line on the attached plan and described in Schedule 2 in the draft Order.
